



## Workshop to Engage Civil Society Organizations in the Implementation of the Fifth OGP National Action Plan (2021-2025)

### Open Government Partnership (OGP)

The Open Government Partnership is a multilateral initiative that aims to secure concrete commitments from governments to promote transparency, empower citizens, fight corruption, and harness new technologies to strengthen governance in the spirit of multi-stakeholder collaboration.

Jordan officially joined OGP in 2011 as the first Arab Country which fulfils the OGP eligibility criteria. The Ministry of Planning and International Cooperation was the official body to coordinate and follow up on Jordan participation in the OGP. Since 2018 the Ministry established the Open Government Unit, which is mandated for follow up on Jordan commitment to the OGP and enhancing the Open government practices in the country.

### Purpose of Workshop

The purpose of the workshop is to engage civil society organizations and experts in the implementation of the Fifth National Action Plan under the OGP which will be implemented over 4 years from (2021-2025). The 5<sup>th</sup> NAP includes six commitments and was developed in a participatory manner with various stakeholders. During the workshop, CSOs and experts will discuss with governmental implementing agencies the detailed executive plans for each commitment, on which they will also provide their comments and feedback regarding CSOs role throughout the implementation phase.
